Smoking Ordinance No. 04-06 Declaration of Intent to Allow Smoking

According to St. Joseph County Smoking Ordinance No. 04-06: Section 5, Letters E and L, Any bar or tavern or restaurant/bar which:

1. provides written notice as a part of its annual application for retail food establishment license to the Health Department that it intends to allow smoking,
2. intends to serve only patrons over the age of 18,
3. and that this election may be made only twice a year (other than an initial enrollment period of three months after the effective date of this ordinance: 4/10/06)*
4. and allows no employee under the age of 18 hired after 4/10/06

is hereby considered an establishment where smoking is not regulated.

Understanding also that declaration of intent to allow smoking must be disclosed in writing no later than 7/10/06, according to initial enrollment period stipulation.
